

RESOLUTION NO. 023-2022

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HAWAIIAN GARDENS, CALIFORNIA, EXPRESSING A VOTE OF NO CONFIDENCE IN LOS ANGELES COUNTY DISTRICT ATTORNEY GEORGE GASCÓN

WHEREAS, the City of Hawaiian Gardens places a high priority on public safety, and has a history of supporting legislation and ballot initiatives that increase public safety and protect the community; and

WHEREAS, the City of Hawaiian Gardens is always striving to provide a safe, welcoming community where families, residents and visitors can live and visit an peaceful community with low crime rates; and

WHEREAS, Los Angeles County District Attorney George Gascón has instituted a series of policies and practices (including Special Directives) that do not properly serve the City's goal of increasing public safety and providing a safe and welcoming community.

WHEREAS, it is important to the City Council of the City of Hawaiian Gardens that policies that aim to restructure or amend prosecutorial directives be consistent with state law, and issued with reasonable intent and priority to protect the general public and victim's rights.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HAWAIIAN GARDENS, CALIFORNIA, DOES HEREBY FIND, ORDER, AND RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The foregoing recitals are true and correct.

SECTION 2. The City Council of the City of Hawaiian Gardens affirms a vote of no confidence in Los Angeles County District Attorney George Gascón and hereby directs Staff to transmit this resolution to interested offices and organizations.

SECTION 3. The City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this Resolution.
