ADOPT RESOLUTION NO. 016-2021 TO CONTINUE THE FISCAL YEAR 2020-21 BUDGET AS THE INTERIM BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEARS 2021-22 UNTIL THE ADOPTION OF THE FINAL CITYWIDE BUDGETS FOR FISCAL YEARS 2021-22 AND 2022-23

SUMMARY

A combination of COVID-19 impacts on City operations, uncertain revenues from the closure and partial reopening of the Gardens Casino, and changes in staffing resulted in the need for additional time to review and complete the proposed 2021-2022 and 2022-23 Fiscal Year Budgets.

The agenda item to consider adoption of the next two fiscal year budgets will be brought to Council in July 2021. Until that time, the City is required to make routine payments for goods and services, as necessary to perform the day-to-day operations of the City. For this reason, staff recommends adoption of the attached resolution, to establish that the FY 2020-2021 Amended Citywide Budget will continue to be in full force and effect until formal action is taken to approve and adopt the Citywide Budgets for Fiscal Years 2021-2022 and 2022-2023.
