RECOMMENDATION:

RECOMMENDATION TO ADOPT RESOLUTION NO. 020-2022, APPROVING A WRITTEN AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF HAWAIIAN GARDENS AND REVOLUTION FOODS, INC. REGARDING FOOD SERVICES FOR THE SUMMER FOOD SERVICES PROGRAM.

SUMMARY

Every summer the City of Hawaiian Gardens conducts a Summer Food Services Program. This program provides free meals, Monday through Friday, for youth in our community. Proposed serving dates for 2022 are: June 13, 2022 – August 19, 2022. Lunches will be served at three locations throughout the City, between the hours of 12:00 PM and 1:30 PM. The lunch locations are: C. Robert Lee, Lee Ware Park and Teen Center.

This resolution would allow the city to enter into a service agreement with Revolution Foods, Inc. to prepare and deliver meals for this program. Being that the Summer Food Services Program is a federally funded program; the city would be reimbursed for all costs associated with the meals.

FISCAL IMPACT

The City would pay Revolution Foods Inc. \$3.60 per lunch served. The City would then be reimbursed for the costs of each meal by the federal government. \$51,000 is currently budgeted in the general fund budget (operational costs) for this program.
